Writing tone + Style Guide

Conversational, easy to understand UK English for young Malaysian readers.

Basic style quide:

- Manglish: Used sparingly in localised fun stories. (Lah, wah, haih are okay)
- Italicise non-English terms: budak | Don't italicise terms with no English equivalent: roti canai
- **Date**: 17 June, 17 June 2020
- **Time:** 4.19PM in headline, 4.19pm in articles
- Measurement: 18KG in headline, 18kg in articles
- Numbers: Spell out single digit numbers, use numeral for double digit and above (one, nine, 10, 20)
- Numbers: Use numeral in headline (10 Things You Need To Know About The Samsung Galaxy S21)
- Book, movie, video, song names: Single quotation in headline, Italicise in story
- **Use Oxford comma:** Coffee, tea<mark>, and juice.</mark>

Headline: 90-character limit

Write In Title Case

Description: Tease readers to read on. Max two sentences.

Cover image: 770px x 375px No text, logo, or watermark

Collage images are recommended and can be made on Canva.

Headlines, Descriptions, Segment Titles, and Excerpts

It comes in a vibrant red and gold theme. And the usual hat, ship, dog, and other tokens you find in the original Monopoly set have been replaced with 'gold' CNY versions!

The tokens are golden tangerines, a lion head, a bull, a firecracker, a gold ingot, and a lantern. Fancy.

The rules of the game are also slightly different from the original. **Instead of buying properties, players** buy shops, collect gifts, and find good fortune to win.





Segment Title

To give an overview of the story. Scanning through the segment titles should give readers good idea of the story.

No full stop at end of sentence, unless two sentences or more

Excerpt

Complement segment titles by adding important details to the story. 2-3 sentences at most.

Images

Break up your story with images to make it more engaging.

Add image credit & link to source.



- Minimum 600px width
- Use clear images
- Photo Credit + link to source
- Use Asians in photo

Do's & Don'ts

Do:

- Be original; write from your experience and knowledge, if you are inspired by existing content, make sure to give credit
- Do research thoroughly; ensure your article is accurate and supported by credible sources
- Be clear and concise; avoid jargon and complex sentences
- Do proofread your work; our editors will also edit your final article, but you have a higher chance of being selected for publication if your grammar, spelling, and punctuation are already correct

Don't:

- Don't plagiarise; never copy content from other sources without proper attribution
- Don't use offensive or exclusionary language; language that could be considered discriminatory, disrespectful, or alienating to any group will not be entertained
- Don't include unverified information; facts must be accurate and verified through reliable sources
